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## CONDUCTING LESSONS

### **How Long are Apollo Music Lessons?**

Music lessons are 30-45 minutes long, depending on what has been organised, and are planned to occur weekly. Regular lessons cease during the school holidays.

### **How do At-School Lessons Work?**

If lessons are conducted during school hours (class time, recess or lunch time), the music teacher will collect each student from their classroom, teach their lesson in the music room, and return them once completed.

### **How after/before school lessons work?**

Before-school and after-school lessons conducted on school premises may require the student to meet their teacher at the music room. We are in contact with the school, and aim to up to date with events as much as possible. We adjust the timetable where necessary and keep parents in the loop when this occurs.

### **How are In Studio Lessons Conducted?**

Lessons are conducted at Apollo Music Academy's studio in Leopold/Drysdale, parents bring students to the studio, check-in, and the teacher will collect their students from the waiting area. Parents are welcome to stay in the waiting area for the duration of the lesson or can return at the time the lesson finishes.

### **What are students required to bring to lessons?**

In both instances (school premises or studio), students are required to bring their musical material (i.e. music journal, notepad, folder, music books, and instrument (if required) each week.





## AVAILABILITY

### **How does availability work?**

Lessons are subject to available spots, but we strive to avoid waiting lists where possible. Once you have a lesson day and time organised, that will be locked in unless cancelled.

### **Is there a waitlist?**

If a particular teacher or lesson type does not have any spots available, we will attempt to offer alternative solutions to avoid being put on a waiting list.



## PRICING & INVOICING

### **How much are Private Lessons?**

Private Lessons (1-on-1) are currently \$40 per 30-minute lesson.

### **How Much are Group Lessons?**

Group Lessons (4-6 Students) are currently \$30 per 45-minute lesson.

### **How does invoicing work?**

Lessons are set up and invoiced per term, and automatically roll over until cancelled.



# GROUP VS PRIVATE LESSONS



## Why Private Lessons?

- Benefits students that require 1-on-1 attention
- Lessons can be more student-tailored,
- Opportunities to dive deeper into certain concepts,
- Eligible for catch up lessons if given 24hrs notice.

## Why Group Lessons?

- Many students learn better within peer learning contexts
- Opportunity to regularly perform in front of peers, reducing performance anxiety
- Opportunities for collaborative learning
- A more cost-friendly price point



## Should I sign up for group or private lessons?

## IMPORTANT TERMS & CONDITIONS

### **Do you offer catch-up lessons for groups?**

We DO NOT offer catch-up lessons for students in group classes.

For missed private lessons, a catch-up lesson will be arranged by Apollo Music Academy when eligible.

### **What happens if I miss my lesson?**

A student is eligible for a catch-up lesson when Apollo Music Academy is notified of a student's absence at least 24 hours before their scheduled lesson. In instances where there is an excursion, incursion, or school-related event conflicting with the lesson time, a catch-up lesson will be arranged.

### **What happens if my music teacher is away?**

In the event that a music teacher is unable to instruct the student or group, whether due to illness or other unforeseen circumstances, and a suitable replacement cannot be organised, a catch-up lesson shall be scheduled.

Credits will be issued if a catch-up lesson cannot be conducted before the conclusion of the term. These credits will be manifested as a free lesson in the subsequent term.
